<b>Miss Adams</b>	<b>Japan</b>	Children will learn about the famous artwork 'The 12 views of Mount Fuji', find out more about beautiful Japanese clothing and even learn about Japanese writing.
<b>Miss Clarke</b>	<b>Spain</b>	Children will learn a Spanish Song. We will read the Hungry Caterpillar in Spanish and learn the day days of the week and numbers. We will produce some Picasso inspired art work and learn about the beautiful country of Spain.
<b>Miss Barry</b>	<b>India</b>	Children will look at famous Indian landmarks made from a variety of rocks. They will locate them on a map and learn about their history. Children will also study some of the country's animals, such as the peacock and will create a rangoli pattern. They will learn about some of the country's traditional children's games and will learn about the art of creating the perfect samosa!
<b>Mr Bibby</b>	<b>Italy</b>	During International Week, we will be learning to count in Italian The Class will learn about and draw the Leaning Tower of Pisa. We will make some typical Italian Pizza and We will make a life-size map of Italy, discovering the geography of the country.
