Graduation Policy

Students are required to complete 12 years of education. Normally this would be:-

- Reception (Foundation)
- Year 1 (Key Stage 1)
- Year 2 (Key Stage 1)
- Year3 (Key Stage 2)
- Year4 (Key Stage 2)
- Year5 (Key Stage 2)
- Year6 (Key Stage 2)
- Year7 (Key Stage 3)
- Year8 (Key Stage 3)
- Year9 (Key Stage 4)
- Year10 (Key stage 4)
- Year11 (key Stage4/5)

At the end of Year 6, students are assessed as to their ability to enter the Secondary School

At the end of Year 11 (fast track) or Year 12 (Key Stage 5) students 'graduate' from Secondary School

- Fast track students complete their IGCSE examinations at the end of Year 10. This enables them to study advanced ('AS') levels in year 11 before graduating.
- Other students take their IGCSE in year 11 graduate then take their 'AS' levels in year 12.

This depends on the students' abilities, attitude to study, parents' wishes country chosen for University and nationality.

Some students choose to complete Year 12 to take 'A' level examinations for study in the UK, US, Canada, Lebanon, Jordan, Syria, Egypt.
